The Sorrow of Sarajevo

context

personification

The Sarajevo wind

leafs through the newspapers

that are glued by blood to the street

I pass with a loaf of bread under my arm.

imagery → wind = turmoil; casual - "reading" newspapers

imagery → death

→ scarce food: his casual manner
implies that death is an everyday
occurrence

hyperbole

personification

The river carries the corpse of a woman.

as I run across the bridge → survival

with my canisters of water, → scarce resources

I notice her wristwatch, still in place.

→ the narrator is numb, notices details,
isn't horrified by the scene - desensitized
TIME - stopped?

Somebody lobs a child's shoe

into the furnace. Family photographs spill

from the back of a garbage truck;

they carry inscriptions:

Love from ... love from...love ... repetition

imagery

the shoe isn't needed anymore
the innocent children are
dying as well

even the memories are gone;
whole families are wiped
out

There's no way of describing these things,

not really. Each night I wake

and stand by the window to watch my neighbour

who stands by the window to watch the dark.
